



INTERIM LWN CLUBHOUSE RULES

Will Be Reevaluated January 2024

The Clubhouse is a place for members to relax, entertain and connect with family and friends. The Clubhouse atmosphere and operations are different from the Tiki. A beautiful, modern and upscale environment has been created for member enjoyment. We want to preserve this.

Members have the responsibility to know and to observe the rules. Member owners who lease their property are responsible to inform their tenants of the rules. All family members and guests must be always accompanied by a member. Children 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

DRESS CODE

Proper attire is required while utilizing the Clubhouse facilities. It is expected that members, families and guests be dressed appropriately. Club management reserves the right to make determinations regarding inappropriate or questionable attire. The dress code can be altered by management to accommodate events.

THE PALMER DINING ROOM - CHAMPIONS and EAGLE DINING ROOMS

For gentlemen, polo shirts, shirts with collars and sleeves, sweaters, pull-overs, golf/dress shorts, tennis attire are permitted. Shirttails must be tucked in at all times. However, straight hemmed boxed shirts, such as Tommy Bahama and similarly designed styles are permitted. Jeans may be worn if they are in condition representative of a county club, no ripped, torn or tattered jeans. Footwear must be worn in the Clubhouse at all times, no flip-flops or athletic slides.

For ladies, blouses with or without collars or sleeves, dresses, skirts, skorts, golf/dress shorts, sweaters, pullovers, jackets and tennis attire are permitted. Jeans may be worn if they are in condition representative of a county club, no ripped, torn or tattered jeans. Footwear must be worn in the Clubhouse at all times, no flip-flops or athletic slides.

The following attire is prohibited, wearing ripped or torn jeans, cargo pants, t-shirts, athletic t-shirts, tank tops, halter tops, athletic gym wear, uncovered sports bras or other bra-style tops, excessively revealing clothing or exposed undergarments, or any clothing with offensive language or images, swim, pool attire, or flip-flops. Hats are not permitted in the Palmer or Champions and Eagle Dining Rooms.

For ladies and gentlemen same as above with the addition of hats and visors being permitted

The following attire is prohibited, wearing ripped or torn jeans, cargo pants, t-shirts, athletic t-shirts, tank tops, halter tops, athletic gym wear, uncovered sports bras or other bra-style tops, excessively revealing clothing or exposed undergarments, or any clothing with offensive language or images, swim, pool attire, or flip-flops.



FOOD AND BEVERAGE OPERATIONS

Members must present ID cards to be seated. Guests will not be seated without a member present.

No entry for Reciprocal players, Interim Tennis members, public golfers.

No outside events will be booked during the interim rule period expiring December 2023, with the exception of golf tournaments.

DINING ROOM RESERVATIONS

There will be a 15-minute grace period for reservations.

Tables will have a maximum part size of 8 people. All parties that exceed 8 will be split into two tables.

Reservations not cancelled within 48 hours will be charged a \$25 fee or the events fee per person.

The following rooms may be reserved by members with the requirement that there is a paid food element that meets the listed spending food requirements below:

Eagle Room	\$500
Champions Room	\$1,000
Palmer Room	\$2,000

CELL PHONES

As a courtesy to other members, all cell phones must be on silent/vibrate mode while in the Clubhouse and Fireside Patio. Cell phone conversations should be kept to a minimum so as not to disturb others.

SMOKING

Smoking, including the use of E-cigarette, Vape devices, and Chewing Tabaco is prohibited within 50 feet of all buildings

PARKING

Cars and golf carts are not permitted to park under the portico or anywhere in the circular drive. This area is for loading and unloading. Do not block any sidewalks.
